

UNEXCUSED TARDINESS / EARLY RELEASES

Policy Code 4400-R

For purposes of the compulsory attendance law and/or Student Code of Conduct reasons, a student will be considered unlawfully absent for one school day when the student accumulates unexcused tardies and/or unexcused early releases occurring on six or more school days in excess of thirty minutes each day.

A student will also be considered unlawfully absent if the unexcused tardies and/or unexcused early releases accumulate to twenty percent or more of the school days in a calendar month.

This regulation shall not apply to tardies and early releases excused by the principal, or designee.
